Adapting to Wildfire

Your Neighborhood's Evacuation Practice will be on Sunday, Oct. 22nd at 3:00pm

This practice will help our emergency services prepare for evacuation, and inform decisions concerning future housing development in Lucas Valley.

Individual/family planning, preparation and practice is the most critical factor for safe evacuation. Practice, learning what to expect, is essential to your planning and preparation.

The evacuation practice area will include homes from West Gate to Miller Creek.

Please Participate!

Invest in the future of your community, and your safety.

You will receive notification of a practice Evacuation Order from AlertMarin around 3:00pm

- If you have not done a driveway drill recently, this is your opportunity to put your evacuation plan to the test: People, pets, and Go Bags in your evacuation vehicle and ready to go in 15 minutes or less (note your time from AlertMarin notification to ready)
- If you have done your evacuation practice, just bring your vehicle and help learn from the traffic challenges we may face in an event requiring mass evacuation
- Consider bringing your Go Bags (or Go Bag checklists) for review with Office of Emergency Management staff

Drive your evacuation vehicle east on Lucas Valley Rd. to the Sheriff's Office parking lot behind 1600 Los Gamos Drive

- This 10 minute drive may take longer than usual, so you may want to bring water and snacks, definitely your mobile device - and leave some people and pets at home
- You will have an opportunity to ask questions of the Emergency Management staff
- Fire Safe Marin will provide wildfire preparedness information - come test your wildfire knowledge!
